FCTC NEW Website has Launched!

FCTC continues to work on installs from our latest fiber project, as with all industries we are being affected by supply chain shortages. If you live in the town of Dysart and have not been converted it is likely because you have our video services and we have recently received equipment that was not due to arrive until Spring! We will be calling to schedule conversions. If you are a Dysart town customer, *just have phone and / or internet*, please accept our apologies as we must have overlooked your address. Call our office and we will have you converted ASAP.

FCTC has been awarded a Broadband Grant!
We have been awarded just under 50 percent of the total infrastructure cost necessary to implement our Dysart Rural Fiber Project. FCTC has already begun working with our engineers and hope to begin construction in the spring!

As Dysart and Clutier's local service provider, we are proud to say that FCTC has donated \$220,000.00 back to the communities we serve!
