NOTIFY FCTC

Protect yourself from PHISHING

Phishing is when a cyber attacker sends fake or deceptive messages designed to trick you into revealing sensitive or private information. The aim is to collect personal data including login credentials, credit card, social security or bank account numbers.



There are several common and successful methods of attack that cybercriminals can use to retrieve your personal contact and financial information. *Phishing attack* methods include email, phone calls, corrupt software, social media apps such as Facebook, advertisements, and direct text messages.

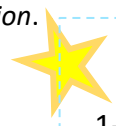
