fiber optic equipment: IN THE HOME

When FCTC converted your home to fiber optics we removed a DSL modem and installed an ONT (optical network terminal). An ONT is a device that connects your home to the signal sent from FCTC. This is most likely located in your basement or where the fiber enters your home/business. For FCTC phone customers there will be a battery back that provides up to 24 hours of power during an outage. These are also available for purchase!





If rebooting of your ONT is required, simply pull the power cord from the ONT and plug it back in.

<u>REMINDER:</u> Your WIFI router may need to be rebooted if you are experiencing buffering or slower speeds. Please follow the same instructions as rebooting your ONT; simply unplug electrically and then plug back in. DO NOT hit the RESET button! This will cause your router to be factory reset and will require a technician to reconfigure.

Please call our office for pricing, you will only pay for the router; set up is free!! If you have a large home and struggle to get a good signal in certain areas, please call our office to discuss adding a Wi-Fi Extender. Remember, connectivity in your home is largely dependent on the number of devices using Wi-Fi as well as the distance the signal is traveling within your home.
